



General Terms and Conditions for Career in Your Suitcase Way Participants

1. Registration fees

All participants must pay the registration to complete the registration process and reserve their place in the program. Until payment is received, the place is only tentatively reserved. Participants are also advised to have a copy of their registration confirmation when arriving at the event in case they are requested to show proof of payment on their arrival.

2. Satisfaction Guarantee

3. Cancellation Policy

At 14 days before the program, registrations may be transferred to another person or postponed to a future offering of the program. At 7 days before the program, registrations may only be transferred to another person.
